So the "Parking Guru" supports parking policy as a remedy to congestion – just as in *Alternatives Approaches* released by Keep NYC Congestion Tax Free.

The following comment accompanies a clip for "StreetsFilm.Org, "<u>Illustrating Parking Reform with Dr. Shoup</u>," that explains how higher on-street parking fee – as recommended by Keep NYC Congestion Tax Free – would significantly address congestion:

Shoup concludes that charging more for curbside parking would free up more parking space, reduce congestion-causing cruising and generate funds for local street improvement projects.
