Q-Poll: New Yorkers Zone Out Congestion Pricing

Voters from New York City and its suburbs strongly oppose the unsustainable, unfair, inequitable & regressive toll-tax <u>scheme</u> known as Congestion Pricing according to a Q-Poll release today Thursday, February 15, 2018. The Quinnipiac University <u>Poll</u> City voters oppose tolling their East River bridges by a dozen points (54-42%) and suburban voters by 19 points (57-38%). The poll also found that "non-white voters oppose congestion pricing 56 - 38 percent."

Clearly the public recognizes *Congestion Pricing* aka *East River Tolls* aka *Zone Pricing* as a policy idea that <u>fails</u> here in just about every way:
